Clear Channel Radio Savannah - 97.3 KISSFM/WAEV & Coastal Pageant Productions, known as ~~the~~ Company+will conduct the Contest substantially as described in these rules and by participating, each participant agrees as follows:

Description of Contest/Participation

- A. **Dates of Contest:** Application registration dates January 12, 2009 . February 28, 2009.: All applications and entry fees must be mailed in no later than February 28, 2009. PERSONAL CHECKS MUST BE POSTMARKED BEFORE FEBRUARY 23. AFTER FEBRUARY 24 ONLY CASHIER'S CHECK OR MONEY ORDER WILL BE ACCEPTED. Day of pageant registration is available from 8:30 a.m. . 9:30 a.m. only for all age divisions. Day of registration fee is \$25. Only Money Order, Cashier's Check or Cash will be accepted day of the pageant. If you mail your entry fee and your money is not received in time for the pageant, you will be asked to pay again the day of registration. If we receive your original entry with fee after the pageant, we will return it to you. No entries will be accepted after 9:30am for all age divisions. The pageant will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday March 7, 2009
- B. **Check-In:** Each contestant must check-in between 8:30 a.m. . 9:30 a.m. on pageant day to be eligible to compete. If the contestant is not present at time of group lineup, she will not be allowed to compete.
- C. **Entry fees are as follows:** Beauty \$75 (required). Best Hair, Eyes, Dress, Smile, & Personality are FREE. Photogenic (optional) is \$15. Checks should be made payable to "Coastal Pageant Productions" and mailed to **Coastal Pageant Productions • 11511 Abercorn St. • PMB 280 • Savannah, GA 31419.**
- D. **Who can enter?** Any girl between the ages of 0-17 years. AGE ON PAGEANT DAY DETERMINES AGE DIVISION ENTERED
- E. **How to enter?** Submit an application and fee according to the timeline above. No Refunds given for any reasons. Returned check fee is \$35.
- F. **Photo's:** All photogenic pictures must be dropped off by 9:30am for all age divisions at the registration table. Name on application (goes by) & age group must be on back of picture. Do not put first & middle names on application or photo unless child goes by both.
- G. **Decisions:** We will have a winner in each age group. If your child was a past age winner, you may still enter the pageant. Judges decisions are final and scores will not be released. There will be 2 overall winners announced, one from the 0-7 yr. age group and one from the 8-17 yr. age group. These 2 ~~Supreme~~+winners will ride in the 2009 St. Patrick's Day Pageant.
- H. **Double Crowning:** A contestant can win her individual age division and still be crowned the Overall or Supreme Winner.
- I. **Photogenic judging:** Photogenic photos must be no larger than 8x10, color or black & white, headshots. All photos must be turned in at registration and picked up at the end of the pageant. We are not responsible for photos not picked up immediately following the pageant.
- J. **Judging process:** Attire should be an age appropriate pageant dress. Judges will be judging on (1) facial beauty (2) attire & overall look (3) poise & (4) personality. Modeling limit on stage will be one minute. Hair & make-up will be at the parent's personal preference. Hair pieces & glitz are acceptable. **IT IS YOUR CHOICE!!** Make your child look her most beautiful.
- K. **Dressing Rooms:** Dressing room area has been moved to the cafeteria. There is NO covered walkway between the cafeteria and backstage. Contestants should come prepared for any type of weather, including wind, drizzle, and rain. We typically have good weather in Savannah in March, but come prepared for anything. Hairdressers and make-up artists are allowed in the dressing room with the contestant. NO males are allowed in the dressing area. A pageant official will be in the room to call when your age group is ready to line up and be escorted from the dressing room to the backstage area.
- L. **Backstage:** There will be one person allowed backstage with a contestant, should they need assistance. If a child prefers her father to walk with her onstage, he will be allowed backstage. Please remember that space backstage is limited, so we only have room for one person per contestant.

Prizes

Each girl will leave with a trophy. Any unsportsmanlike conduct from the contestant, family, or friends will result in disqualification! If a winner is disqualified, the Company reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner's prize in its sole discretion. Age group winners will receive a crown, trophy, & banner. Please do not call to find out how many are in your child's group. This information will not be given out!!

Publicity & Privacy

By participating, all participants and winner(s) grant the Company exclusive permission to use their names, characters, photographs, voices, and likenesses in connection with promotion of this and other contests and waive any claims to royalty, right, or remuneration for such use. By participating in the Contest, participants agree that the Company may disclose personal information obtained from participants in the Contest to third parties and use such information for marketing and other purposes.

Release

By participating in the Contest, each participant and winner waives any and all claims of liability against the Company, its employees and agents, the Contest's sponsors and their respective employees and agents, for any personal injury or loss which may occur from the conduct of, or participation in, the Contest, or from the use of any prize. In order to receive a prize, participants must sign an official waiver form provided by the Company.

Taxes

Any valuation of the prize(s) stated above is based on available information provided to the Company, and the value of any prize awarded to a winner may be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Each winner is solely responsible for reporting and paying any and all applicable taxes. Each winner must provide the Company with valid identification and a valid taxpayer identification number or social security number before any prize will be awarded. If the conduct or outcome of the Contest is affected by human error, any mechanical, technical, electronic, communications, telephone, computer, hardware or software errors, malfunctions or failures of any kind, intentional interference or any event beyond the control of the Company, the Company reserves the right to terminate this Contest, or make such other decisions regarding the outcome as the Company deems appropriate. 2009 Little Miss St. Patrick Frequently Asked Questions

Who can compete? Any young girl between the age of 0-17 (going by their birth date on the day of the pageant)

Entry fee: \$75.00 (mandatory entry fee) \$15 (photogenic) \$5 (each additional photo submitted) \$25 (late fee) No refunds.

Free admission: Each contestant will be given one free admission

What do you win? Winners will receive a crown, banner, and trophy. Strip banners will be awarded for prettiest eyes, dress, etc. Runners up will also receive a trophy. Each contestant will receive a participation trophy.

Who will ride in the parade?

The contestant with the overall highest score in the 0-7 year age group and the contestant with the overall highest score in the 8-17 year age group will be the 2 young ladies that will ride in the parade. These 2 young ladies will be our Supreme winners.

Will the 2 young ladies ride on a float or in a car?

The 2 Supreme winners will ride on the Clear Channel/KISSFM float, along with Miss St. Patrick's Day and her 2 runner ups.

Can a contestant win her age group and be crowned the Supreme winner?

Yes, we will allow double crowning in this pageant.

Are there 2 different pageants this year?

No, for the first time, we are combining all age divisions. There is ONE check-in, from 8:30 a.m. . 9:30 a.m. The pageant begins at 10:00 a.m. We will have several age groups compete, then we will bring them back and crown before moving on to the next set of age groups. A projected schedule will be emailed out one week prior to pageant to those who have entered.

If I'm in the Teen age division, do I still need to check-in between 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.?

YES! Regardless of what age group you are in, you must check in between 8:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. Even if you've paid ahead if you miss check-in you will not be able to compete and will not get a refund.

Who is judging the pageant?

We select experienced judges who either have competed in pageants, directed pageants or have had experienced children compete in pageants. Experience, professional and decisive are the character traits we use in selecting a panel.

What are the judges' looking for?

They will be looking first for a beautiful face followed by a good overall appearance in terms of their hair, make-up, dress and accessories. Make your child look her personal best. Modeling and personality will also be considered.

Who is in the pageant?

We have many children from all over the Coastal Empire who compete with varying levels of experience in pageants. We've seen experienced girls do well and first timers! We will not reveal the names of other contestants or how many are in an age group.

What does each contestant compete in?

Contestants compete in beauty only. Each age group will come out in collective line-up where the judges will decide the optional awards such as prettiest eyes and prettiest dress. Each contestant will come on stage individually after group line-up.

What time does check-in begin? ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK-IN BETWEEN 8:30-9:30 A.M. This is for ALL age divisions.

Check-in will close promptly at 9:30 a.m.! Check-in will take place in the lobby of the auditorium. The pageant will begin at 10 a.m.

When will I be able to pick-up my photogenic pictures?

Photogenic pictures will be available for pick-up after the pageant is over.

What does "Glitz" mean?

Glitz is a pageant term that generally means the dresses are loaded with rhinestones or sequins and the contestant generally uses make-up, eyelashes, hair pieces etc. to dramatically enhance a child's appearance and beauty. Glitz is acceptable. Please refer to **What are the judges looking for?** for more details.

Where are the dressing rooms?

We have moved our dressing room to the cafeteria on campus at Country Day. The cafeteria is the building directly to the left of the auditorium. Please understand that there is NO covered walkway from the cafeteria to the auditorium. This means you will need to be prepared to walk outside, regardless of the weather. Please come prepared should there be wind, drizzle, or even rain. You are encouraged to bring a mirror, power strip, etc. to the cafeteria as you set up. The dressing area will open at 8:30 a.m. on pageant day along with registration. Please do not arrive expecting to have access to the dressing area before 8:30 a.m.

Are Make-up artists and hairdressers allowed in the dressing room?

Yes! Because of our increased size of the dressing area, you are allowed to have these people with you! As always, no men are allowed in the dressing room.

What is the difference between "registering" and "checking-in"?

Registering is done prior to February 28th. Late Registration which has a \$25 late fee, is done between 8:30 a.m. . 9:30 a.m. on the morning of the pageant. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK-IN so they can receive their number, turn in their photogenic pictures and receive pageant information for the day.

What is the admission fee?

Admission fee is \$5 for adults and \$3 for 4-12 year olds. Children under 3 will be admitted for free.

Do you have a photographer or videographer?

KISSFM staff will attempt to photograph each girl as they compete and post the photos for free downloads at 973kissfm.com. Higher resolution prints may be available for a small charge.

What modeling pattern do we use?

We use a basic T formation. Judges will be in the center of the first rows. You may go out on the stage to locate the X's prior to the pageant start time.

Do we have a rehearsal?

No, we do not have a rehearsal prior to the pageant. DO NOT contact the school prior to the pageant.

When is the deadline to register? In order to avoid the late fee, you must have your registration postmarked by Saturday, February 28. You can register the day of the pageant, however, you will be responsible for paying the \$25 late fee (Cash ONLY, please)!

Can I write a check?

PERSONAL CHECKS MUST BE POSTMARKED BEFORE FEBRUARY 23rd. AFTER FEBRUARY 23th ONLY CASHIER'S CHECK or MONEY ORDER WILL BE ACCEPTED via mail with a postmarked date no later than Saturday, February 28. Cash, Money Order, or Cashier's Check will be the only forms of payment accepted day of the Pageant. Return check fee is \$35.

When should I arrive?

Plan to arrive at the beginning of the check-in time. There is no need to arrive prior to the check-in time which is 8:30 a.m.

When will we know our contestant number?

You will receive your number and placement at check-in the day of the pageant.

When do I bring my photogenic picture?

You will bring your photo with you to check-in the day of the pageant. Photogenic will be judged 30 minutes prior to the pageant. Any photograph received after registration is closed will not be judged in photogenic. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN!

Where do I mail my application and fees?

Mail you application and fees to Coastal Pageant Productions at **11511 Abercorn Street / PMB #280 / Savannah, GA 31419.**

Where is the pageant located?

It will take place at the Savannah Country Day School's Jelks Auditorium. Directions: Hwy 204 & I-95 exit #94. Go east towards Savannah about 8 miles. Turn right on Largo Dr by Walgreens. Go less than ½ mile. Turn left on Windsor Rd. Go less than ½ mile. Turn right on Stillwood. Go less than ½ mile and the school is on the left. The auditorium is just past the security gate.

Where can I get an application?

Please log onto www.973kissfm.com to download your application. You may also call our pageant hotline at 912.234.7369, leave your name and address on the voicemail and one will be mailed to you.

How do you determine contestant order?

The first to enter will be the last to compete. Those registering the day of the pageant and paying the late fee will be added to the end of the contestant order.

How do I know if you received my registration fee and application?

We will send an e-mail to the address you provided. Feel free to e-mail us at coastalpageantproductions@yahoo.com for verification of received applications. Sometimes e-mail addresses are hard to read, please make sure that you print legibly!
